Rooms

Chalet Mistral sleeps 14 people in 7 bedrooms.

Bedroom one - Aurora
Double/twin bedroom on the fourth floor; shower room, private dressing area and direct access out onto the terrace with one of the hot tubs.

Bedroom two - Blizzard
Double/twin bedroom on the fourth floor; en-suite shower room.

Bedroom three - Eclipse
Double/twin bedroom on the fourth floor; en-suite shower room, patio doors leading out onto the terrace with access to one of the hot tubs.

Bedroom four - Horizon
Double/twin bedroom on the fourth floor; en-suite shower room, direct access onto the terrace with one of the hot tubs.

Bedroom five - Halo
Double/twin bedroom on the fourth floor; en-suite bathroom with bathtub and shower, direct access onto the terrace with one of the hot tubs.

Bedroom six - Solstice
Double/twin bedroom on the second floor; en-suite shower room and private balcony.

Bedroom seven - Stratus
Double/twin bedroom on the third floor; en-suite bathroom

Eating

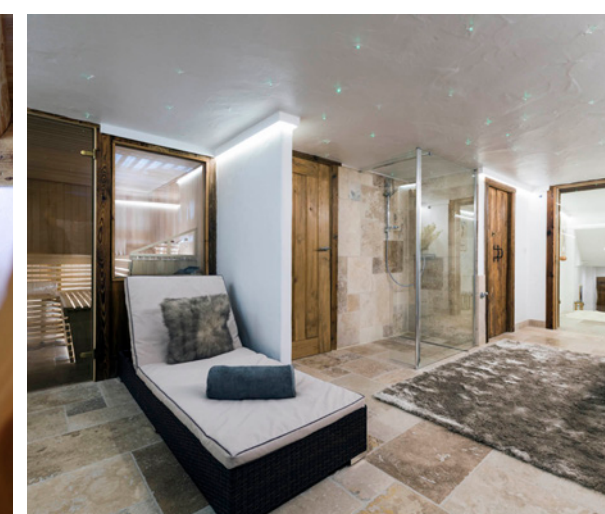
At Chalet Mistral your five star food and drink is included, and the staff have two days off a week.

Every morning you wake up to a steaming cup of fresh tea or coffee in bed, before eating breakfast, cooked just the way you like it.

You'll set off for the day armed with delicious snacks and greeted in the afternoon with irresistible tea-time treats back at the chalet. On five nights of the week the staff serve Champagne and canapés at the cocktail hour, and your private chef whips up a three course gourmet dinner.

Everything is tailored to your requirements, and you'll have an initial consultation with the chef to run through the details. Perhaps some of your party have dietary requirements, or perhaps you would like children's lunches and teas cooked to order. Your word is our command.

A selection of fine wines is served with the evening meal and an à la carte wine list is also available if you'd like something really special, at additional cost. Chalet Mistral also has a fully stocked open bar with spirits beers and soft drinks, so you really don't have to worry about a thing.

Kids

Children are made very welcome at this cosy luxury ski chalet and it is well designed to accommodate families. Within Chalet Mistral there are several areas where the kids can make themselves at home whilst the adults have a little grown-up time. The TV room is well equipped with DVDs and satellite TV and there is also a separate cinema room.

Val d'Isère is a great place for families, offering plenty of activities from lessons on the nursery slopes to swimming at the Centre Aquasportif and trying the indoor climbing wall.

The chalet staff make everything easy for families, organising everything on your behalf, even down to transporting the kids to and from their lessons in a chauffeured car. Equipment such as cots and highchairs are available on request.

Location

Chalet Mistral is located in a ski-in/ski-out location in Val d'Isère in the Espace Killy ski area. The town centre is just a short chauffeured drive away or a ten minute walk.

There are two options when skiing back to the chalet; the first is via a red run know as Piste M which runs just above the chalet, from here it is possible to cut through to the chalet

via a short section of tree lined off piste track. The second is via a blue run called Santons which runs just below the chalet.

The nearest airports are Chambéry, just under 2 hour's drive and Geneva and Lyon, both of which are approximately 3 hours away.
