**Bedroom three (Sendak):**  
Double/twin bedroom with en-suite shower room, TV and private balcony with Matterhorn views.

**Bedroom four (Mickelwhite):**  
Double/twin bedroom with en-suite bathroom, TV and terrace access with Matterhorn views.

**Bedroom five (De Mauriac):**  
Double/twin bedroom with en-suite shower room, TV and terrace access with Matterhorn views.

**Bedroom six (Zbriger)**  
Double/twin bedroom with en-suite shower room and TV.


## Eating

Gastronomic pleasures are at the heart of the Chalet Maurice experience. Your highly accomplished chef uses only the best ingredients and fresh local produce such as Zermatt cheeses and the fruits of mountain hunting trips.

Breakfast, afternoon tea and dinner are all included, as are champagne, house wines, spirits and soft drinks. Everything is prepared with supreme care, and if the menu does not appeal, it can be tailored to your wishes.

The day starts with a cup of tea or coffee in bed, followed by a mouth-watering breakfast feast. In the afternoon, a spread of teatime treats is followed by exquisite canapés at the cocktail hour, and a magnificent evening meal. Home-made chocolates and irresistible desserts are all part of the service. Specially cooked children's suppers can also be provided.

The hand-picked house wines and Perrier Jouët Champagne are excellent quality, and the à la carte wine list offers further choices at an additional cost. Special requests can be arranged in advance – just let us know.

Within the exclusive Petit Village area of Zermatt, Chalet Maurice is set apart and has a private entrance and funicular lift. Electric taxis are the main transport in this car-free resort and the nearest lift and town centre can both be reached within 3 minutes. Alternatively, if you prefer to walk, the centre of Zermatt is a 10-15 minute scenic stroll away.

Zermatt is a car-free resort which has a railway station, so guests often arrive by train.

Geneva Airport is approximately 3 hours drive away.
