Location

Penthouse Tschugge is centrally located on Bodmenstrasse, one of Zermatt's most quiet and peaceful streets.

It is approx. 5mins from the Gornergrat train station, 8mins walk from the Sunnegga ski lift and just a stone's throw away from the main street where all the best restaurants and bars are located. All supermarkets and shops are all very close by and easily accessible.

The closest airport is Sion approx. 1.5 hours away, and Geneva approx. 3.5 hours away.
