We love the attention to detail that has gone into the villa's restoration, from the exposed beams to the plush Italian textiles, every element has been carefully considered and beautifully designed.

The crème de la crème of the villas on the picturesque Murlo Estate, Villa Maestosa is a beautiful old stone building that has been impeccably restored and rejuvenated. Surrounded by greenery in every direction, the villa enjoys sweeping views across vineyards, olive groves and farmland on the hillsides around the estate.

No expense has been spared in turning this ancient building into a thing of beauty. The villa is on several levels, but clever architectural highlights like tall, arched windows and an open-plan layout ensure light pours through the building and into the different nooks and crannies of the social spaces.

There is a real emphasis on natural materials in the design and exposed beams and polished marble can be found throughout, while the walls are a beautiful light stone colour. In contrast to the earthy tones and materials, the soft furnishings are incredibly plush and add splashes of bold colour.

Much like its interiors, the garden at Villa Maestosa is the stuff of luxury magazines. Sprawling out to one side of the villa a large lawn gives way to the infinity pool and adjacent plush pool-house, compete with barbeque and shaded lounge area. For evening meals, there is a shaded lounge set between the main villa and annex, and a pebbled piazza where you can dine with views down the hillside framed by the pretty stone buildings either side.

Villa Maestosa sleeps 8 people in 4 bedrooms, with 2 in the main house and 2 in the annex.

Bedroom 1 – Main Villa
First-floor bedroom with king-size bed. En-suite bathroom with shower.

Bedroom 2 – Main Villa
Second-floor bedroom with king-size bed. En-suite bathroom with shower.

Bedroom 3 - Annex
Ground-floor bedroom with king-size bed and exterior access. En-suite bathroom with shower.

Bedroom 4 - Annex
First-floor bedroom with king-size bed and exterior access. En-suite bathroom with shower.

Eating

Make the most of your luxury home away from home and the abundance of fresh local produce available in the area during your stay here. The spacious kitchen has all the mod-cons you could need to rustle up classic Italian favourites, which are best enjoyed al fresco at the dining table outside the kitchen. For pizza lovers, you'll also find a wood-fired oven here for a true taste of Italy.

Lazy lunches can be served in the pool house and breakfasts are best eaten out in the garden in the cool morning sunshine.

If cooking isn't your thing, why not ask the estate owners to organise for an expert chef to come in and do the hard work for you? Or, perhaps get dressed up for an evening out at the estate's Il Caldaro restaurant, where traditional Umbrian delicacies with a modern twist are always the dish of the day.

If you are here for longer than a few nights, make sure to fit in a wine tasting or cooking class too, both of which can be organised on the estate.

Part of the idyllic infinity pool offers shallow water, ideal for paddling.

Of course, the pizza oven will be a sure-fire highlight, and foodie kids will also love the opportunity to learn to cook with a cooking class on the estate that can be catered to all abilities.

For families with teenagers the the villa’s separate sections come into their own, allowing parents and kids to have their own living quarters, and late-night games to be reserved to the pool house while the parents enjoy dinner party drinks. Table tennis on tap will also make for friendly competitions throughout your stay.

Location

Villa Maestosa is located in the heart of Italy’s Umbrian countryside. As part of the sweeping Murlo Estate the villa enjoys easy access to the

estate’s restaurant and amenities, and there is also a small local village within a 10 minute drive.

Further afield, you can get to Florence in less than two hours and Rome and Pisa in 2 hours 30 minutes, meaning you can choose which city to fly into.
